Membership Costs & Details

Quarterly Invoice Includes:

- **Meal Charge:** \$160 per quarter (covers meals at meetings)
- **Rotary Dues:** \$190 per quarter (supports District 5960, Rotary International, & local club expenses)
- **Initiation Fee:** \$100 (one-time, due with membership application)
 - Includes \$70 processing charge & \$30 donation to Rotary International Foundation

Total Yearly Cost: **\$1,770**

(Covers meals, dues, and Foundation donation)

Additional Expenses:

- **Guests:** \$20 per guest per meeting
 - *Potential members and program speakers attend for free!*
